

Charles Lindbergh's 1927 transatlantic solo flight from New York to Paris launched an aviation revolution and made him one of the most famous Americans in the 20th century. Explore his original furnished childhood home to learn how his childhood experiences shaped the legacy he would create. Learn about his contributions to aviation, medical science, environmentalism, and complex viewpoints through the museum's interactive exhibits. Discover the beauty of the Mississippi River by walking the hiking trails connecting into Charles A. Lindbergh State Park. See for yourself where a dream took flight!

Suggested time at the house and museum is two hours, but you may stay longer if you wish. Includes a guided house tour which lasts about 45 minutes.

Transportation is on your own. It is about a 35-minute drive from the River's Edge Convention Center to the house & museum in Little Falls. When you arrive at the museum, identify yourself as being with the Order of the Eastern Star.
